## 1. Objectives

This course is intended for anyone seeking to improve their level of aviation English (pilots, cabin crew, ATCOs, AMTs...), and its structure have in mind pilots and controllers who are preparing the ICAO English proficiency test.

It is focused almost exclusively on improving listening and speaking skills, considering the six dimensions of language proficiency described by ICAO: pronunciation, structure, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension and interaction.

## 2. Structure

Course duration is 30 hours, divided into 15 weekly classes of 2 hours each.
